Example - Communication takes place in: the home, school, daycare, friends, grandparents, events, Doctor's office etc.

0 to 6 months - most infants sleep a lot of the time and wake for eating, drinking and diaper changes

6 to 12 months - most infants sleep less and become more curious about their surroundings.

12 to 18 months - learn to walk, eating, drinking, playtime and napping

18 to 24 months - Developing more curiosity "2 years old behavior"

24 to 36 months - make new friends in day care or with neighbors

36 to 42 months - more social- learning to interact and play with others

42 to 48 months - play a lot in daycare, the park, and with friends

48 to 54 months - begin JR Kindergarten

54 to 60 months - go to SR Kindergarten
